CALL FOR CONCEPT NOTES UNDER THE CIVIL SOCIETY

Under the Vietnam Country Strategy Paper (CSP) 2007-2010, a Civil Society Facility was established at embassy level to support innovative development activities of civil society organisations that will contribute towards the achievement of the CSP goal “to promote and support the equitable reduction of poverty and vulnerability in Vietnam”.

Irish Aid is currently inviting concept notes for its 2010 funding round. Priority consideration will be given to interventions which inform poverty reduction and social protection policies for vulnerable groups. The Civil Society Facility focuses on the following areas: disability, HIV & AIDS, and local participation and planning.
