I am the deciding officer in this case. I am refusing to grant your request on administrative grounds. Where access has been refused, the records are exempt from release under the following sections of the Act Sections 15 (1)(a) the record concerned does not exist or cannot be found after all reasonable steps to ascertain its whereabouts have been taken.

Right of Appeal
