Staff at Ireland's Embassy to Canada perform a wide range of functions in pursuit of Ireland's foreign policy interests. These include representing and advancing government policies; economic, trade and cultural promotion; frontline consular and passport services to Irish citizens and engaging with the Irish community. From time to time there are events and commitments that would have arisen on an ad-hoc basis which may not appear in the Ambassador's diary.

Right of Appeal
