I refer to the request which you have made under the Freedom of Information Act 2014 for access to records held by this Department, as follows:

Details concerning aid to Syria, in particular, the announcement in April of this year of € 25 million in aid. I request full details of this aid and to whom it was given. I would also like to know how much of this aid was given to the government of Syria.

I refer also to the acknowledgement of your request which was sent to you on 6<sup>th</sup> October 2017.
