## News about Ireland

The <u>Taoiseach</u> and Prime Minister Cameron have today invited the Northern Ireland parties to talks to address the critical issues which threaten the stability of the devolved institutions.

The latest economic data from Ireland is strong. The economy grew by 4.8% in 2014 and growth of 4% is expected in 2015, the highest growth rate in the EU in both years. Export levels are at an all-time high. Unemployment was at 9.5% in August 2015 from a peak of 15.1% in 2012.

In August the Minister for Foreign Affairs and Trade launched a <u>report</u> on the successes of St Patrick's Day 2015 around the globe.

In August Google announced the establishment of a new Operations Centre in Dublin, which will work with location based products Google Local and Google Maps. Google expects this to create 200 new jobs immediately.
