News from Ireland

Speaking to the European Parliament in the first of a series of debates on the Future of Europe, the Taoiseach <u>stressed the importance of our common values</u> and of remaining united to address the challenges of the 21st century.

The Taoiseach also delivered the <u>keynote speech</u> on National Holocaust Memorial Day to the Holocaust Education Trust Ireland, concluding "…we can never recover what was lost. All we can do is share a warning from history and send a message of hope that will resonate for all time."

Tánaiste and Minister for Foreign Affairs Simon Coveney, undertook a <u>4-day visit</u> to Cairo, Jerusalem, Tel Aviv, Ramallah and Gaza where he met with leaders on a range of bilateral and regional issues including the Peace Process.

2018 will be a year of intense activity in support of the Irish language. Bliain na Gaeilge 2018, a year-long programme of events, and a social media initiative on Twitter, #TrasnaNadTonnta, kicked off in style. Dublin City University has also developed a <u>free online Irish Language course</u> ("Irish 101") for the global diaspora and new immigrants.

CSO statistics confirmed that 2017 was a <u>record year</u> for overseas visitors to Ireland, up 3.6% over 2016. Visits from North America were up 16.2%.

Tributes were paid to singer Dolores O'Riordan and former Attorney General and EU Commissioner Peter Sutherland following their deaths in January
