- Within one month of arrival in Ireland, holders of Working Holiday Authorisations must register with the Garda National Immigration Bureau and will be issued with a Certificate of Registration on payment of the appropriate fee;
- Working Holiday Authorisations are issued on an individual basis. Holders of Working Holiday Authorisations shall not seek to be accompanied or joined by a spouse or dependents;
- Permission granted to those entering Ireland on the basis of a Working Holiday Authorisation shall be valid for a maximum period of twelve (12) months from the date of entry into Ireland.
- Extensions to the period of validity of such permission shall not be granted. Participants must leave Ireland on the expiration of the permission, which cannot be extended nor renewed, either under the authorisation itself, or through attempting to convert it to a different form of immigration status;

- Those who might otherwise qualify for a Working Holiday Authorisation but are already in Ireland with an immigration status other than that based on a Working Holiday Authorisation may not convert to permission based on a Working Holiday Authorisation without leaving the State and re-entering on the basis of the valid Working Holiday Authorisation;
- I understand that it is my responsibility to make an prospective employer aware of the time limits on my work authorisation;
