16th June at 18h, Casa Guilherme de Almeida – Anexo, Rua Cardoso de Almeida, 1943

This year, <u>Casa Guilherme de Almeida</u> will mark the 50th Anniversary of the first translation of Ulysses into Brazilian Portuguese with a celebration of this work, and a reading of Ulysses in various languages, musical receitals and theatrical performances.

The event will be opened by Deputy Consul General Ciara Gilvarry, and will feature contributions from Antônio Houaiss, Haroldo de Campos and Caetano Galindo.
