Dear Mr. Smyth,

I refer to the request which you have made under the Freedom of Information Act 2014 for access to records held by this Department, as follows:

- The amount of money spent by the Department on document shredding services in the years 2014 to 2019 (to date).
- The figures broken down into each year.

The figures in the table below pertain to the cost of shredding services across the entire Department. That includes the Passport Service along with our missions abroad.

I refer also to the acknowledgement of your request, which was sent to you on 29th August, 2019.

I am the deciding officer in this case. I have identified 1 record that falls within the scope of your request, and I have made the decision to grant release of 1 record. The record released is attached.
