I refer to the request which you have made under the Freedom of Information Act 2014 for access to records held by this Department, as follows:

Any documents, including correspondence, memoranda, briefings, minutes or submissions, held by the department which relate to the decision by Israel to blacklist and ban activist group, Ireland Palestine Solidarity Campaign, excluding inquiries from media and statements provided to the media.

I refer also to the acknowledgement of your request which was sent to you on 17 January 2018.

I have identified one record that falls within the scope of your request. The record is listed in the schedule attached. I have made a decision to grant this record.
