Dear Requester,

I refer to the request of the 22nd May 2018 which you have made under the Freedom of Information Act 2014 for access to records held by this Department, as follows:

- 2. Correspondence between Dóchas and Minister Ciaran Cannon (sent and received) on sexual misconduct issues in NGOs funded under Irish Aid, between 1st January and 20th May 2018.
