I refer to the request which you have made under the Freedom of Information Act 2014 for access to records held by this Department, as follows:

Copies of all correspondence sent/received by the Minister(s) in relation to smartphones or internet access for minors since 2016. This should include all correspondence including letters, emails etc. And it should include correspondence from members of the public as well as official representations.

I refer also to our conversation in this regard and my subsequent email message of 6 June.

I have identified no records that fall within the scope of your request. In that light I am refusing it on administrative grounds under Section 15(1)(a) of the Act the record concerned does not exist.

Right of Appeal
