including details of the numbers of Irish citizens living abroad who will be asked to reregister their details on the new dfa.ie/travel/citizens-registration and in what countries they reside;

including all records concerning what has happened to the personal data of citizens on the old (pre-migration) database and whether that database has been decommissioned and the personal information destroyed;

including details of any additional cost to the final project due to the inability to migrate data directly from the old system;
