I refer to the request which you have made under the Freedom of Information Act 2014 for access to records held by this Department, as follows:

“Under the FOI Act 2014, I request access to records of all communication to the Department of Foreign Affairs and Trade from Hillary Clinton and from the Department of Foreign Affairs and Trade to Hillary Clinton between 1 June 2015 to 1 June 2016.”

I refer also to the acknowledgement of your request which was sent to you on 21 June 2016.

After an extensive search of the Department’s records, I can confirm that we have not identified any records that fall within the scope of your request.
