I have identified 29 records that fall within the scope of your request. I have made a decision to grant full access to 1 record and refuse 28 records. The records are listed in the schedule attached.

The main section of the 2014 Freedom of Information Action under which the records are refused is section 31(2). This provision relates to records that relate to proceedings which are currently the subject of tribunals or other review mechanisms chaired by a judicial authority. In addition a number of other records are refused under section 28 of the Act.
