Dear Mr. O'Callaghan,

I refer to the request which you have made under the Freedom of Information Act 2014 for access to records held by this Department, as follows:

Under the FOI Act 2014 I request a list of the names of each Bulk Personal Dataset held or controlled by the Department, and, for each dataset:

- a) the purposes for which the dataset is held,*
- b) the size of the dataset (in terms of either gigabytes of disk space, or number of individuals, or both),*
- c) how many copies of the dataset are in existence in the department, and the source of that figure (ie whether that figure is as a result of copy control measures, a comprehensive audit, or is an estimate).*

If any part of the above is not held for any particular dataset, it is sufficient to say that that part is unknown.

This request relates to electronic datasets held by the Department containing information related to members of the public.

I refer also to the acknowledgement of your request which was sent to you on October 7, 2016.


As the responding officer, I have identified 1 record that falls within the scope of your request, which is listed in the attached schedule.

The appeal will involve a complete reconsideration of the matter by a more senior member of the staff of this Department.
