**Applications for nomination as a judge of the European Court of Human Rights**

Applications are sought for nomination by the Government as a candidate for election as a judge of the European Court of Human Rights. The judge elected will take office generally no later than three months following his or her election. The term of office is for nine years and is not renewable. The position is full time and is based in Strasbourg.

Article 21(1) of the European Convention on Human Rights requires that judges be "of high moral character and must either possess the qualifications required for appointment to high judicial office or be jurisconsults of recognised competence." Furthermore, Article 21(3) states that "[d]uring their term of office the judges shall not engage in any activity which is incompatible with their independence, impartiality or with the demands of a full-time office."

In accordance with Article 22 of the Convention, three candidates will be nominated by the Government from amongst whom the Parliamentary Assembly of the Council of Europe will elect, by a majority of votes cast, a judge in respect of Ireland to serve on the Court. The election by the Parliamentary Assembly of the Council of Europe is scheduled to take place at its session in April 2015.

In accordance with Resolution (2010)26 of the Committee of Ministers of the Council of Europe, before the names are submitted to the Parliamentary Assembly, the candidates' CVs will be submitted to the Advisory Panel of Experts on Candidates for Election as Judge to the European Court of Human Rights established by the Committee of Ministers to advise on their suitability for the office of judge of the European Court of Human Rights.

Following submission of the three names to the Parliamentary Assembly, the candidates will be interviewed by the Parliamentary Assembly's Committee on the Election of Judges to the European Court of Human Rights prior to election by the Plenary.

**Iarratais d'ainmniú mar bhreitheamh ar an Chúirt Eorpach um Chearta an Duine**

Tá iarratais á lorg d'ainmniú an Rialtais mar bhreitheamh ar an Chúirt Eorpach um Chearta an Duine. De ghnáth rachaidh an breitheamh a roghnófar don phost i mbun oibre laistigh de thrí mhí ó dháta a roghnaithe. Maireann téarma na hoifige ar feadh naoi mbliana agus ní féidir é a athnuachan. Post lánaimseartha atá ann agus beidh sé lonnaithe i Strasbourg.

De réir Alt 21(1) den Choinbhinsiún Eorpach um Chearta an Duine ní mór do bhreithiúna "carachtar morálta den scoth a bheith acu agus na cáilíochtaí atá riachtanach do cheapachán in oifig ardbhreithiúnach a bheith acu nó a bheith ina ndlí-eolaithe a n-aithnítear a n-inniúlacht." Deir Alt 21(3) freisin "le linn a dtéarma in oifig, níl cead ag breithiúna a bheith páirteach in aon ghníomhaíocht a chuirfeadh isteach ar a neamhspleáchas, a neamhchlaontacht nó leis na héilimh a bhaineann le hoifig lánaimseartha."

De réir Alt 22 den Choinbhinsiún, ainmneoidh an Rialtas trí iarrthóir agus astu siúd roghnóidh Tionól Parlaiminteach Chomhairle na hEorpa, trí thromlach na vótaí a chaitear, breitheamh ar son na hÉireann le freastal ar an Chúirt. Tá sé beartaithe an toghchán a dhéanfaidh Tionól Parlaiminte Chomhairle na hEorpa a reáchtáil le linn a sheisiúin i mí Aibreáin 2015.

De réir Rún (2010)26 de Choiste na nAirí den Chomhairle Eorpach, sula dtugtar na hainmneacha do Thionól na Parlaiminte, tabharfar CVnna na n-iarrthóirí do Phainéal Comhairleach Saineolaithe ar Iarrthóirí do Thoghchán mar Bhreitheamh ar an Chúirt Eorpach um Chearta an Duine a bhunaigh Coiste na nAirí chun comhairle a thabhairt faoina n-oiriúnacht don oifig mar bhreitheamh ar an Chúirt Eorpach um Chearta an Duine.

Tar éis an trí ainm a chur chuig an Tionól Parlaiminteach, cuirfidh Coiste Thionól Parlaiminte um Breithiúna a Roghnú chuig an Chúirt Eorpach um Chearta an Duine na hiarrthóirí faoi agallamh sula dtoghann na Suíonna Iomlánacha iad.

Tá an Coinbhinsiún Eorpach ar Chearta an Duine agus Rún CM/Res (2009)5 de Choiste Airí na Comhairle Eorpaigh faoi stádas agus coinníollacha seirbhíse do bhreithiúna den Chúirt Eorpach um Chearta an Duine ar fáil ag:
