- 1. Cyprus shares the view that explosive weapons have a devastating impact on civilians and civilian objects around the world. Their use in populated areas has been shown to cause long-term humanitarian harm, which far outlasts the conflicts in which they are used.
- 2. The deaths and injuries caused, as well as the destruction of houses, schools, hospitals and other critical infrastructure, means that the civilian population in severely affected over the long-term.
- 3. This destruction also acts as a catalyst for the displacement of people, rendering the displaced persons or refugees vulnerable to exploitation and abuse.

- 4. Cyprus strongly supports the Political Declaration on strengthening the protection of civilians from the humanitarian consequences arising from the use of explosive weapons in populated areas.
- 5. We believe that the reaffirmation of the obligations of all parties in armed conflict under applicable international law is a crucial element of the Declaration. These obligations include compliance with International Humanitarian Law under all circumstances, including of course when conducting military operations in populated areas.
- 6. We welcome Ireland's leadership in promoting this important Declaration and we express our gratitude to the Irish Ministry of Foreign Affairs for hosting this crucial adoption conference.
