The Embassy of Ireland is delighted to hold the concert series *The Last Rose of Summer* together with Mendelssohn-Gesellschaft e.V. for the second year running. The Embassy has been proud to call the beautiful building that is Jägerstraße 51, the former company headquarters of the Mendelssohn Bank, its home since 2010. We consider ourselves privileged to have such wonderful neighbours in the Mendelssohn-Gesellschaft e.V. The Mendelssohn Remise has proved to be a fantastic venue for many of the Embassy's previous events. We are therefore delighted at the opportunity to once again collaborate with our neighbours in the creation of *The Last Rose of Summer* concert series.

The connection between Ireland and the Mendelssohns of course extends well beyond these premises. *The Last Rose of Summer* concert series is named after a famous song based on a traditional Irish melody. The lyrics originate from the pen of the Irish poet Thomas Moore. Moore composed the song in 1805. During the 19th century Moore's 'The Last Rose of Summer', along with his other 'Irish Melodies', enjoyed great popularity. The piece was set to music a number of times, the most renowned version being Felix Mendelssohn-Bartholdy's Fantasy op 15 about the Irish song 'The Last Rose'.

The roses of County Kilkenny are said to have served as inspiration for Moore's poem. I can assure you that the roses of Irish gardens continue to be just as beautiful, even after all these years, and that Ireland's enormous musical range is unparalleled. I would encourage you to visit Ireland to discover the country's natural beauty and musical variety for yourself.

From 29 August until 2 September 2016 you are invited to enjoy five lunchtime concerts featuring young talented musicians from Germany, Ireland and beyond. I am certain that the music will provide the perfect accompaniment for a lively and relaxed start to the autumn season.

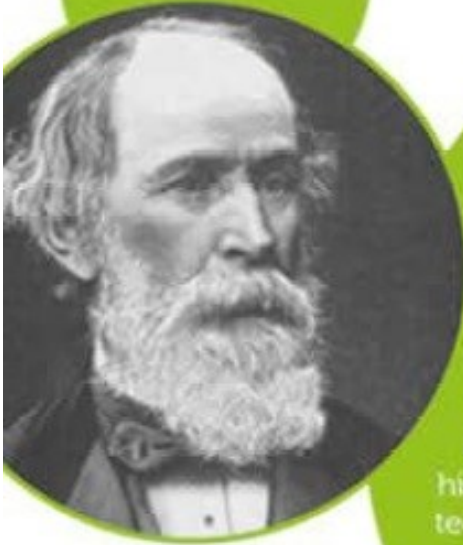


Commemoration of William T. Mulvany, 1 July



COMMEMORATIVE EVENT TO CELEBRATE THE LIFE AND ACHIEVEMENTS OF WILLIAM T. MULVANY

Initiative conceived by the NRW chapter of the Irish Business Network e.V.



BACKGROUND

William T. Mulvany was born in 1806 in Dublin. As an employee of the board of works, Mulvany worked to provide employment for the impoverished population through large drainage and road construction projects.

Due to funding disagreements Mulvany left Ireland and eventually settled in the Ruhr valley and later Düsseldorf, Germany. Mulvany always stayed true to his Irish roots and as a reflection of this he incorporated an Irish aspect into all of his many projects.

- Mulvany was instrumental in establishing the first industrial coal mines in the Ruhr valley and indeed Germany. These were called Hibernia, Erin and Shamrock.
- Having mined over 70 million tons of coal these mines formed the basis for the energy concern E.ON which is one of the biggest energy providers in Europe.
- This was possible by seed money being provided from, among others, Henry Bewley. This was one of the first recorded cases of the use of venture capital, a very important tool in modern commerce.
- Miners and engineers were brought from Ireland, Durham and Lancashire England. Mulvany designed and built purpose accommodation for his employees.
- This accommodation was revolutionary in its day and set the standards for worker accommodation in Germany from then on.
- These new miners brought many customs to Germany most noticeably football which rapidly established itself in the Ruhr and went on to become what is now Germany's national sport.

Further achievements

- Mulvany designed and commissioned the construction of all the major canal systems in NRW which are today a vibrant part of the local infrastructure.
- Mulvany designed a new type of boats to be used on his canals.
- Mulvany designed the then main train station in Düsseldorf.
- Mulvany designed and commissioned a church for his workers which is still active today.
- Mulvany founded the Düsseldorf stock market and designed the building which housed it.

The establishment of the stock market proved to be the deciding factor in establishing Düsseldorf as a major economic and financial centre which as the capital of NRW is now one of the richest and most successful cities in Germany. Similarly Düsseldorf is a national hub for IT Telecommunication finance, fashion and design.

Few if any German nationals, not to mention non German nationals have influenced the broad industrialisation of Germany, on so many levels, to the extent Mulvany has.

In recognition of his achievements, Mulvany was awarded a special award from the Kaiser in recognition of his outstanding contribution to German industrial economic and financial development. Many places and infrastructure throughout the region have been named after Mulvany in recognition of his enormous contribution to society. These include roads, schools and beer just to mention a few.

PLANNED EVENT

In keeping with other events, organized by the NRW chapter of the Irish Business Network e.V., this will be a matrix style day of events with the following highlights:

- A bus tour of the NRW region to highlight Mulvany's physical contribution to society including
- A tour of his coal mines
- Canal systems
- Housing
- The stock market
- E.ON headquarters where a bronze of Mulvany stands
- Visit to the shipping museum in Düsseldorf with presentation.

In the early evening, we will have a large formal reception with ambassadorial and ministerial presence from both Ireland and Germany.

Presentations will be given highlighting Mulvany's achievements.

We also plan to have a video art show with excerpts from a film shot in 1931 depicting Mulvany miners deployed in a successful rescue operation of trapped French miners.

The evening will be interspersed with live music. We plan to unveil/present a physical memorial.

Perfect Friction in Germany

The band Perfect Friction effortlessly connects Irish folk music with pop while remaining true to its authentic roots. The four women and two men band are a discovery of the Irish Spring Tour and have not yet performed in Germany outside of the tour. The band originate from County Wicklow and, like so often, emerged from local music sessions which included vibrant dancing as well as modern pop music. Their sound is a mixture of modern pop and rock music fused with traditional musical elements. At the moment a new generation of fantastic musicians is emerging in Ireland. This new generation mixes the genres to the highest level without neglecting traditional music roots.

Louise Kelly is the voice of the band. She is a trained singer who loves everything to do with singing; from Irish A-capella, Gregorian chant, Latin songs to Indian Hindu classics. She recently performed for the Dalai Lama. The group of sisters in the band, the Cullen sisters, are truly talented. Lottie is regarded as one of the best Irish players of the Irish bagpipes known as the Uilleann Pipes and has toured since her youth while successfully completing her piano and violin exams. Her sister Courtney is already the three-time Irish flute and violin champion and wrote the biggest hit of the band to date 'Irish Love'. Debbie Byrne, on the other hand, was crowned accordion champion at the tender age of seven and always makes sure to pack her dance shoes. She is also a multi award winning dancer and will be kept on her toes with the band's vibrant dance performances. Laura Callaghan is known for her skilled guitar playing and by her side is Bodhrán-Champion Robbie Walsh. By Irish standards, he came late to the music scene and became the All-Ireland champion at aged 18.

Walking on Cars, 11-13 August 2016



Haldern Pop Festival, 11-13 August 2016

Walking on Cars is a band founded by five school friends from Dingle, a small coastal town in the south-west of Ireland. The band rapidly developed from being a group of musicians performing at song-writing sessions in provincial Ireland to being one of Ireland's most successful alternative rock bands. "For two years we travelled around Ireland", the band's drummer Evan explains. "And from a certain point onwards, the shows were sold out and we had our first hits. And all this worked without a label, without press officers; we did all that completely on our own. The only aim was to save enough money so that we could eventually record our first album". After first successes and tour trips through Ireland, a multitude of music labels tried to sign the young band and in 2014 they accepted *Virgin EMI's* offer. Since then, things really took off.

The singles *Catch Me If You Can* and *Two Stones* entered the Irish top 30, the former even topping the Irish iTunes charts. The EPs *As We Fly South* und *Hand In Hand* also climbed up in the iTunes charts.

Last year the band went on tour with the British band *The Kooks* and played several sold-out concerts in Dublin and London.

After publishing their single *Speeding Cars* in November 2015, they released their debut album *Everything This Way* on 6 May 2016.

The band will play three concerts in Germany this summer: at *Rock am Ring* on Friday, 3 June, at *Rock im Park* on 4 June, and at Haldern Pop Festival (11-13 August).
