## YOUNG IRISH CREATIVES

The Embassy of Ireland is excited to announce a festival of young Irish creativity taking place in Berlin in November 2018. It will celebrate and showcase the quality and diversity of Irish artists currently working in Berlin and across Germany. The focus for 2018 will be on music and literature as well as an exhibition of works by Irish visual artists held in the Embassy.

Irish visual artists are invited to submit entries for inclusion in this exhibition by **15 June 2018**. The competition is open to all Irish artists living or working in Germany. Young is defined as a state of mind!

Works by 5 artists will be selected for exhibition by a panel including Seán Kissane, Curator of Exhibitions at IMMA and Dr. Katja Blomberg, Director, Haus am Waldsee. Each of the 5 exhibiting artists will receive €200 in recognition of their costs and one overall winner will receive a cash prize of €1000 sponsored by the German Irish Culture Society e.V.

The scale and format of works submitted should be appropriate for exhibition at the Embassy. All visual media are eligible. However, artists should be aware that it may not be possible to keep all sculpture and installation pieces on display for the duration of the exhibition. Successful artists will be responsible for the transport of their work to and from the Embassy.
