

**Documentation required when applying for a visa to  
join a spouse on a work permit in Ireland**

MUST BE INCLUDED WITH THE APPLICATION  
AS INCOMPLETE APPLICATIONS WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED.**

All documents listed must be original and must include a copy where you want  
the original returned.

All documents must be in English or  
accompanied by a notarised translation

1.	Online summary sheet, signed and dated by you, the applicant – you must ensure that your online application has been fully completed		Not required
2.	Your original passport, valid for at least 6 months after your date of departure from Ireland with at least 2 blank visa pages. Please include a photocopy of the passport bio page, all visas and all stamps. If you hold other passports or have held previous passports, you must submit them with your application. If you are unable to do so, a written explanation must be provided along with any relevant police reports		
3.	1 recent photo that conforms to requirements detailed here <a href="http://www.inis.gov.ie/en/INIS/Pages/Photo%20Requirements">http://www.inis.gov.ie/en/INIS/Pages/Photo%20Requirements</a>		Not required
4.	Evidence of your permission to reside in the UK (stamp, sticker or residence card).		
5.	Processing fee (postal orders or bank drafts should be made payable to the Embassy of Ireland). Note: Payments for postal applications should be by postal order or bank draft only.		Not required
6.	The original marriage certificate ( a photo copy is not acceptable)		
7.	Evidence of your spouse's permission to remain in Ireland including: (a) a copy of their valid work permit (b) a copy of their passport showing the bio page and the Irish Immigration stamps giving permission to work (c) a copy of their GNIB registration card		
8.	Your spouse's P60 from the most recent tax year		
9.	Your spouse's most recent 3 consecutive payslips		
10.	A detailed bank statement from your spouse covering the 6 month period immediately prior to your application		
11.	Details of your spouse's accommodation in Ireland		
12.	<b>For postal applications, a self addressed Special Delivery envelope for return of your passport and documents</b>		Not required
