We were delighted to have the first Ministerial visit to Mexico in some years for St. Patrick's Day and were honoured to welcome the Minister for Justice, Equality and Defence, Alan Shatter TD, to Mexico. Visit of Minister Alan Shatter to Mexico



Minister Shatter's visit was part of the Government's Promote Ireland programme undertaken annually to build trade, economic, and cultural links with Ireland's key partners. During his meeting with Secretario Meade the Minister updated him on trade cooperation since the President's visit, the Mexico - Dublin Investment conference (more below) and the increased activity by Irish companies in Mexico this year. An important message by the Government for the St. Patricks Day period is to highlight that Ireland's economic recovery is gathering pace. The Minister had a number of engagements with representatives of the business community in Mexico to discuss opportunities and carried out a series of press engagements. Visit of Lord Mayor of Dublin

The Lord Mayor of Dublin, Oisin Quinn visited DF and Guadalajara from 4-7 March. programme focused on promoting Dublin's Digital sector and planning for the first ever Mexico Investment conference in Dublin in The Lord Mayor met with Mayor Mancera, Secretary of the Economy Ildefonso Guajardo, the Coordinator of Mexico's National Digital Strategy, Alejandra Lagunes, the Mayor of Guadalajara and representatives from COMCE and ProMéxico. Ambassador Hyland hosted an event with business, tourism and education contacts to discuss with the Lord Mayor the opportunities for cooperation and investment in Dublin and Ireland.
