	Documents Required	Check Box
1	Fully completed and signed visa application form	
2	Current passport with 2 clear pages and valid for at least 6 months after your return from Ireland	
3	Previous Passports (if any)	
4	Copy of your current internal passport (marked pages only)	
5	2 colour passport photographs(one to be glued to the top left of your application form). Photographs to accompany applications should be a minimum of 35mm x 45mm and a maximum of 38mm x 50mm in size.	
6	Letter of invite from the charity in Ireland, setting out the following details: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Name and date of birth of each child being brought to Ireland • The dates of proposed entry and exit • A declaration that the charity will be responsible for the costs of the trip, the welfare of the children and their return to their home country. 	
7	A full list of the host families being used to accommodate the children including names, addresses and contact telephone numbers.	
8	Declaration signed by a representative of the charity that all host families have been appropriately vetted or will be vetted before the child is placed with the family. If the host family is not vetted before the child travels to Ireland the charity must make arrangements to have the child placed with a family which has been vetted.	
9	Copy of the child's birth certificate. (This should include English translation)	
10	Notary permission to travel from either parents or the legal guardian of the child. (This should include English translation)	
11	Copy of both parents passport details page to verify signature.	
12	If one of the parents is missing (their location is not known, they are deprived of their parental rights by a court's decision, they are dead) – evidence of same is required. <u>This should include English translation.</u> For the legally appointed guardian – evidence of the appointment (e.g.: a court's decision). <u>This should be translated into English.</u> It must be clear from the documents submitted who has legal guardianship/custody of every child.	
13	Letter from studies (school/college) (This should include English translation)	
14	If you have been refused a visa for any other country, details of this must be given. Submit a copy of the letter issued to you by the authorities of that country. Concealment of visa refusals will result in your Irish visa application being refused
