CONSULAR LETTER

Confirming Pension/Income for Thai retirement and Spouse visa

- 1. Your original Irish passport
- 2. A request form (enclosed) OR your own letter, indicating i) your residential address in Thailand ii) contact telephone number and email address iii) the amount of your monthly/annual pension/income iiii) pension/income name.
- 3. Bank statements (3 months) showing details of the pension/income which goes to your account
- 4. Letter from your Employer or Government offices confirming the amount of your annual pension/income
- 5. Consular letter fee: 1,800 Baht
- 6. Postage fee: 100 Baht (optional)
