 ii) contact telephone number and email address iii) the amount of your weekly/monthly/annual pension/income iiii) pension/income name.
- An official letter from your Employer or Government offices confirming the amount of your annual pension/income (all letters submitted must be on official company headed paper)
- Bank statements (at least 6 months) showing details of the pension/income which goes to your account.
- **Fee:** 1,600 Baht
- Postage fee (optional): 100 Baht
