## Documentation required when applying for a BUSINESS visa to travel to Ireland

All documents must be **ORIGINAL** (unless otherwise stated)
All documents must be in English (or be accompanied by a notarised translation)

## **Important Notes**

- All letters should be dated within the 4 week period immediately prior to your application date
- The Visa Officer reserves the right to request additional documentation, if required, in support of your application
- The provision of all of the documentation listed does not guarantee that a visa will be granted

1. Application Form:	
Online summary application form, signed and dated by you, the applicant	
2. Passport(s):	
<ul> <li>Your original passport, valid for at least 6 months after your date of departure from Ireland with at least 2 blank visa pages</li> </ul>	
If you hold other passports, or have held previous passports, you must also submit them with your application. If you are unable to do so include a written explanation along with any relevant police reports	
<ul> <li>Photocopy of your bio-page and all visas and stamps in your passport(s) – all immigration stamps and visas for all.</li> </ul>	
3. Photo:	
2 recent photos (not more than 6 months old) that conforms to the requirements detailed here: <a href="http://www.inis.gov.ie/en/INIS/Pages/visa-application-photos">http://www.inis.gov.ie/en/INIS/Pages/visa-application-photos</a>	
4. Residence Permission:	
Evidence that you have permission to reside in the country from which you are applying.	
<ul> <li>Photocopy of your permission to reside in the country from which you are applying (copy of front &amp; back</li> </ul>	_
of residency card or stamp or sticker in passport)	
5. Previous Visa Refusal Details:	
Details of any previous Irish visa applications you have made, including any which were refused	
• Details of any visa refusal(s) for any other country. Failure to disclose previous visa refusals will result in	
your Irish visa application being refused	
Photocopy of any original documentation to do with previous visa refusal(s)	
6. Processing Fee:	1
<ul> <li>Please check our website to see if you are required to pay a fee. Applications submitted by post must</li> </ul>	
include proof of payment. Applications submitted at Embassies or Honorary Consulates must be paid for	
in cash. No card payments can be accepted.	

7. Letter of support from your Employer:	
<ul> <li>A signed letter from your employer confirming that you are undertaking this travel on the company's behalf. It should contain information about the purpose of the travel, frequency and duration of trip(s), who is responsible for the costs of the trip(s) (travel, accommodation, expenses etc.). The letter must be on headed paper with the company's contact and registration details.</li> </ul>	
Please note that if you are employed by a company which also has an Irish office and your travel is to visit the	
Irish side of the company you must submit a letter from your employer on headed paper with the their <u>contact</u>	
and registration details.	
8. Letter of invitation from Irish company:	
<ul> <li>A signed letter from the Irish company that is inviting you to Ireland for business purposes. It should contain information about the purpose of the travel, frequency and duration of trip(s), who is responsible for the costs of the trip(s) (travel, accommodation, expenses etc.). The letter must be on headed paper with the company's contact and registration details.</li> </ul>	
Please note that if you are employed by a company which also has an Irish office and your travel is to visit the	
Irish side of the company you must submit a letter from the company on headed paper with the <u>Irish contact</u>	
and registration details.	
9. Evidence of Funds:  If you are personally responsible for the costs of your intended business travel you must provide:	
A written explanation of why you are personally responsible and not your employer or inviting company	
Your 3 most recent payslips.	
<ul> <li>Your up-to-date bank statements for the 6-month period immediately prior to your application showing most recent transactions for the account, including any salary or other regular income, up to the date of your application. These must:</li> </ul>	ä
<ul> <li>Be original or a print-out which has been stamped by a branch of your bank</li> </ul>	
<ul> <li>Show your current address</li> </ul>	
O Show availability of sufficient funds to cover the costs of your proposed trip. Lump sum	
lodgements made shortly before your application will not be considered
