Under the Irish Development Experience Sharing Programme (known as IDEAS), full financial support is provided for one-year full-time post-graduate education for candidates from Vietnam at the Smurfit Business School of the University College Dublin (UCD) in Ireland. The purpose of the Irish Aid IDEAS Scholarship Programme is to provide talented candidates with the opportunity to pursue advanced education and professional development in Ireland in order to contribute to the future development of Vietnam. The Irish Aid Scholarship Programme normally covers: return airfares, full tuition, stipends to cover accommodation and subsistence costs, health insurance and other allowances, in addition to the necessary entry arrangements such as medical examination and visa.

To Apply

In order to be eligible for this programme, you MUST have:

- Received a letter of admission from UCD Michael Smurfit Graduate Business School. For application for admission, please visit www.ucd.ie/smurfitschool.
- Met entry standards of the UCD Smurfit post graduate programme (i.e. IELTS and GMAT requirements).
- Met any relevant procedural requirements of Government of Vietnam.

Irish Aid particularly welcomes candidates from ethnic minorities, candidates living with disability or candidates from disadvantaged groups in Vietnam.

To apply, please fill in the attached application form, paying special attention to the following criteria:

- Your commitment to returning to work in Vietnam following graduation.
- Your proposed future contribution to the social and economic development of Vietnam

- 5. One letter of reference from your employer.
