You can apply for an Employment (permits etc.) visa after you have obtained your employment permit from the <u>Department of Enterprise</u>, <u>Trade and Employment (DETE)</u>. There are different types of employment permits issued by DETE including Critical Skills Employment Permits and Work Permits.

You can apply for an Employment (Permits etc.) visa up to 3 months before your date of travel to Ireland. The submission of all or any of these documents does not guarantee that your application will be successful.
