ONLINE PASSPORT RENEWAL SERVICE FOR PASSPORT

Renew online to save time: If you are aged over eighteen and need to renew your passport you should use the online service. This service is convenient, secure and offers a swift turnaround service. No need for forms, witnessing or printed photos. It is the most efficient, cost-effective and stress-free way to get your passport. To apply online visit <u>www.dfa.ie/passports</u>.

DOWNLOAD THE TRAVELWISE APP

The app includes travel advice and consular information on 200 countries with information on security, local laws, entry requirements, health and emergency contacts. Security alerts are sent to App users that have accepted push notifications and opted to receive alerts for a specific country or countries. Alerts will only be sent on major changes in the overall security status or in the event a specific crisis event or emergency.

The App provides a secure and easy to use facility to register with the local Irish Embassy or Consulate. This is a voluntary online service which encourages Irish citizens travelling or living overseas, especially those in higher risk destinations, to register their contact details with the Department. In the event of an unforeseen crisis such as a natural disaster or civil unrest, the Department can proactively contact the citizens, ensure they are safe, keep them informed of developments and provide assistance where necessary.

Topical Articles includes practical information on major events abroad. A "Know before you go" section provides cross-cutting information relevant to multiple travel types and destinations. This includes passport information, travel insurance information and the consular role of our embassies network. The "My Trip" checklist is a handy tool to help travelers ensure that they are well prepared for an upcoming journey. **You can access the app through iStore and Google Play.**

AFRAID OF LOSING YOUR PASSPORT? APPLY FOR A PASSPORT CARD

You can apply for a passport card through the Department of Foreign Affairs and Trade website or through an app which can be downloaded for free. An Irish citizen (over the age of 18) who is in possession of a valid passport can apply for the card online from anywhere in the world. An applicant can take a photograph of themselves on their mobile phone or webcam or upload a photo, test to confirm that the photograph meets the international standards for passport photographs and complete the entire application process on their smart phone or through the DFAT website. This includes on-line payment. The fee for the passport card is \in 35 and there is an additional \in 5 postal fee if you reside outside Ireland.

The Passport Card is credit card-sized so it fits conveniently into a wallet or purse. The new passport is accepted for travel within the EU and EEA (includes the EU plus Iceland, Norway and Lichtenstein). Applicants will need to have a valid passport book already but they will be able to use the passport card alone for travelling within the EU and EEA.
