The handwriting is different from the rest of the birth certificate. On your own birth certificate your parents' first names were written in separately from the rest of the information, in a different pen and with different hand-writing. No explanation for this discrepancy has been submitted.</p> <p>SP:- Previous educational or employment background is at odds with course applied for. - The applicant has not sufficiently set out to the Visa Officer why they have chosen this particular course given your previous employment or educational history. As per the INIS website where the course you now wish to study does not naturally follow on or relate to your educational or employment history, you must give reasons, supported by documentary evidence (where available), for this change. It is also noted that the course chosen mainly deals with the Irish taxation.
