Hold a passport with at least 6 months validity, valid visa, these detail must match with the passport.

Have sufficient funds for the period of stay in Ireland or a sponsor letter from the employer.

Have confirmed one way tickets, proof of contact details in Ireland.

The grant of an immigration pass to you will be determined by the Irish Naturalization and Immigration Services (INIS) at the port of entry. The period of stay has been shown on the Employment pass endorsement given on your passport and it is not tied to the validity of this visa. Please check your passport for the arrival endorsement and take note of the period of stay granted before leaving the check point.
